





Unite for Seniors this Giving Tuesday - Extend the Gift of Holiday Wishes

Dear Friends of Seniors Outreach,

As the season of giving approaches, we are reaching out to you with an urgent call to make this Giving Tuesday extraordinary for our seniors. On November 29th, Seniors Outreach kicks off its 'Holiday Wishes' campaign, and your support is crucial, especially for vulnerable low-income seniors facing isolation.

Caring for our aging community members remains a top priority. We are steadfast in our commitment to ensuring they stay healthy, connected, and engaged with peers and the community through our programs.

The Challenge: Loneliness and Social Isolation

Older individuals, particularly those facing economic challenges, are susceptible to loneliness and social isolation, with severe implications for their health. Factors such as aging, mobility, retirement, bereavement, or health challenges can lead to prolonged periods without meaningful social interactions. This isolation can trigger depression and a significant decline in physical health and overall well-being. This year, our seniors faced additional challenges with rising living costs and climate disasters. Research from Interior Health shows that only 37% of Kelowna residents report a strong sense of belonging and that socially isolated seniors are 4-5 times at greater risk for hospitalization.

Our Response: Seniors Outreach Services

At Seniors Outreach, we take pride in supporting our oldest community members. Our social services, recreation programs, and at-home services are designed to provide vital social connections and prolong independence and wellness. An example is our outreach and home supports that help over 600 seniors. We recently talked with 98 of these participants, most over 80 years of age, and were happy to learn that with our supports:

- 99% feel more secure with remaining independent in their home
- 96% know where to go for help if a problem were to occur
- 81% feel better connected with their community

While this feedback helps us know what is working and where to focus more efforts, we also worry about the larger group of 6,000 seniors in our region living on low-income, many who struggle in silence and could benefit from a helping hand and social supports.

Fundraising Focus: Social Connections

This year, we are raising funds to enhance our social programs that we deliver with our caring volunteers. Our services include friendly visiting, meal deliveries, grocery shopping, minor home repairs, coffee club, technology supports, social recreation and peer supports.
