### **Better at Home: Real Impact for Local Seniors**

Better at Home is more than a service: it's a lifeline for local seniors who want to stay safe, comfortable, and connected in their own homes. The program offers subsidized home support services for seniors with a modest income and limited family support. The non-medical services include housekeeping, grocery assistance, yard work, minor home repairs, transportation, snow removal, and friendly visits.

In a recent survey, 91% of participants said the services helped them better manage daily tasks, 85% felt more connected to community supports, and 91% highlighted the reliability and friendliness of staff.

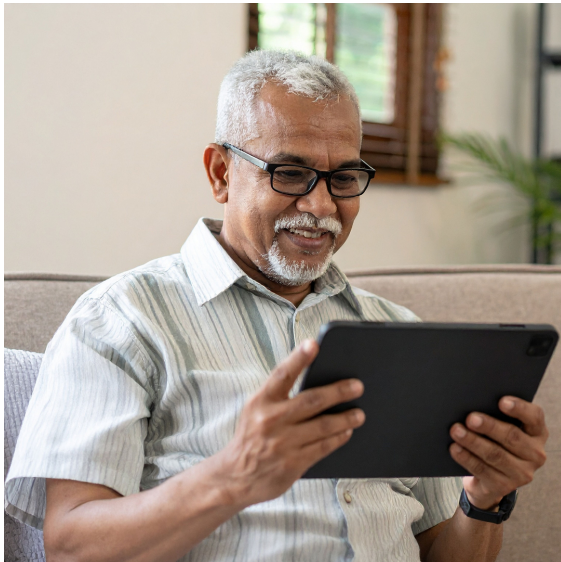
**“The supports have been amazing and improved my life. I want to stay in my house and neighbourhood for as long as possible, and it helps getting the house cleaned, lawn mowed and snow cleared,”** said M, age 93.

Last year, the program helped 609 seniors and engaged 92 volunteers in



service delivery. The program is funded by the Government of B.C. and is managed by United Way British Columbia- a valued community partner with for our local healthy aging programs!
